ITEMS TO PURCHASE AT LOCAL MUSIC STORES

- FOUNDATIONS FOR SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE by Richard Williams and Jeff King
For your specific instrument
- Lyre – for clarinets, saxes, trumpets, horns (trumpet clamp-style), and trombones. For euphoniums and tubas, buy the longest available type, and I will bend it for you to use. Take your instrument with you to be sure you get one that will fit. This is needed for performances in the stadium.
- Individual instrument supplies (reeds, mallets, mouthpieces, valve oil, slide/cork grease, swabs, stick bags, etc.)
- Personal Digital Tuner/Metronome with a Korg or Peterson Clip-On Pick-Up Microphone (percussionists do not need this item). The Korg TM-50 is the preferred model.

ITEM TO PURCHASE AT GENERAL RETAIL STORES

- Black 1" D Ring binder (You will replace it should you lose it or it becomes unusable). Please do not buy anything larger.
- Index dividers (you need 5)
- Pencil Pouch that will fit inside your binder (only for pencils - not for mouthpieces)
- 3 - 5 Pencils (you are expected to have a pencil every day – replace when necessary)
- Luggage tag – to label your instrument with your name and any other contact information you wish to include. This is very important, as many instruments look the same, and it is rather upsetting to play on an instrument that you think is yours only to discover that it is not.

INSTRUMENT SPECIFIC ITEMS TO PURCHASE AT LOCAL MUSIC STORES

Trumpets: Denis Wick Straight Mute

Horns: Schilke 30C2 Mouthpiece

Trombones: F attachment Trombone (if you don't already have one)
Schilke 51 Mouthpiece (bring trombone to make sure you get the correct size)

Euphoniums: Schilke 51D Mouthpiece (small shank for Yamaha instruments, large shank for King)

Percussion: New stick/mallet purchases will follow in a later e-mail.
